KITT

KITT is a linear lighting installation with an individually configurable length. Satinized tubes with specially developed LED boards are controlled using curated programming. With a variable light spectrum of white, colored as well as moving light, rooms can be animated according to the desired mood. The installation is attached to the ceiling by custom-made loops made of woven metal straps.
